BARBER INSTRUCTOR TRAINING

ENTRANCE INTERVIEW GIVEN BY SCHOOL DIRECTOR TO DETERMINE IF CANDIDATE HAS THE POTENTIAL OF BECOMING A BARBER INSTRUCTOR.

| 5. | SUPERVISED PRACTICE TEACHING | 100 HRS. |

EXIT INTERVIEW BY THE SCHOOL DIRECTOR CERTIFYING THAT THE CANDIDATE IS PREPARED FOR THE STATE BOARD INSTRUCTOR EXAMINATION.

- Any currently licensed Ohio Barber may enroll in this course. In order to obtain an instructor license, the barber must have a minimum of (18) months experience working in a licensed barber shop.
- A barber student after completing (1800) hours and obtaining a barber license may enroll in the barber instructor training course; however, he/she will not be fully licensed until completing (18) months working in a licensed barber shop.
- All instructor candidates must have pre-approval for this program from the Ohio State Barber Board.

NOTE: The school has the right to set a fee, or not set a fee for this training.

It is the school's discretion for requiring full time or part time training.
